Attention Grade 1 to 3 Parents!

It's time to update your child's immunization record. You must update the health unit any time your child receives a new immunization. If your child is not immunized, you will need to provide the health unit with a medical exemption or affidavit to keep on file.

Before going off on summer holidays, take a few moments to make sure your child's record is up to date. Here's how:

1. <u>Check</u>: Your child's yellow immunization card. 2. <u>Contact</u>: Your child's family physician or health-care provider to obtain records, or to get missing vaccinations. 3. <u>Share</u>: Visit the health unit's website and use a secure online form <u>immsonline</u> to enter their complete record, or Fax a completed record to <u>705-726-3962</u>.

Every student in Simcoe County and Muskoka must have an up to date immunization record (or medical exemption/affidavit) on file at the Simcoe Muskoka District Health Unit – it's the law. For more information, or to speak with a nurse on the health unit's immunization team, call 705-721-7520 or 1-877-721-7520.


